

Mud Drags

Track Guidelines

General

- No racing event is risk free. It is our hope that these guidelines will minimize the risk and achieve our ultimate goal of hosting a safe motor sports event.
- Two Redneck Rally Officials will be present.

Track Layout

- The track length will be 175 feet in length.
- The width of each lane will be a minimum of 25 feet.
- The distance between lanes will be a minimum of 10 feet, unless a structural barrier will be present.
- All timing systems are set with a rollout of 16 inches.
- The shutdown area length is 410 feet with a track length of 175 feet and the area is wider than the width of the race area.
- The shutdown area is smooth, free of obstacles and debris, and prepared to create a non-tacky surface.
- Track conditions for the Redneck Rally Mud Drags are relatively smooth, free of large rocks and debris, and 4 to 16 inches in depth. The amount of water on the track is up to the discretion of the track official. Standing water is not recommended.
- The track officials are not responsible for weather changing actual track conditions at the time of the race.

Spectator Location

- Spectators are not allowed within 40 feet for the entire length of the race track.
- A structural barrier (guardrail) is located between the track and the spectators.
- No spectators are allowed in the area directly behind the race track.
- Every track is different and we have setup the safest possible layout for the location.
- There is bleachers setup on the south side of the pits and 20 paid parking spots on the north. For reservations contact Greg at 605-484-4564.

Safety Equipment

- Only safety personnel are allowed in the shutdown area and next to the race track.
- A paramedic or EMT and one ambulance from the Edgemont Volunteer Ambulance Service will be on sight before a race starts. A backup ambulance is available.
- The Edgemont Volunteer Fire Department has CO2 fire extinguishers are on site. The optimum location for the devices will be determined by the fire department. Also, the fire department has extraction tools (jaws of life) on site.
- Any donations to the Edgemont Volunteer Fire Department and Ambulance Service are greatly appreciated.
