ATV/UTV Obstacle Course

Rules

\$15 race entry fee

Everyone will be charged a \$5 gate fee as they enter!

1. All racers will have and wear helmet, goggles, long pants, long sleeve shirt, and shoes. Gloves and chest protector are recommended, but not required.
2. All ATVs must start from the designated start line.
3. When the flagger waves the green flag, you can start.
4. The ATV and driver must stay within the event markers. If either leave the course, they must back up until they are back within the course boundaries before continuing forward.
5. If a driver wishes to appeal a decision, it must be done before the next ATV run begins. Once the next ATV run is started, the run becomes final and cannot be appealed.
6. Intentional unsafe riding will result in disqualification.
7. Disabled vehicles will be moved at the completion of the race.
8. The drivers' meeting is mandatory! Drivers may walk the track or ask for a guided tour.
9. The track is closed to all foot traffic and leisure riding once races begin.
10. The speed limit is 5 mph when not participating in an event.
11. Anyone impaired will not be allowed to compete.
12. Riding is allowed ONLY between pits and event.

JUDGING

1. Track judges and the event manager will review all scenarios not covered by the rules.
2. Decisions of the event manager and judges are final.

RIDERS CONDUCT

1. All riders shall conduct themselves in a respectful manner.
2. All riders will be in control of their machines during operation. If a participant is deemed reckless or lacking control, they will be disqualified.

COURSE RULES

1. The right to rework the course at any time during the event is reserved.
2. Stock and modified machines are allowed.
3. Any tire size will be allowed; chains or spikes will not.
4. No burnouts will be allowed in the staging areas or between the staging area and the starting line.
5. After completing a race, riders will immediately head to the pit area.
6. All riders wishing to compete **MUST** attend the drivers' meeting before the race can begin.
7. Once a rider enters the staging lanes, there will be no exiting.
8. The flagman controls the run.
9. In case of a breakdown, riders are responsible for hooking a towrope to his/her machine; any and all damages incurred when being pulled are the responsibility of the rider.
10. Any course infraction will result in a 5 second penalty for each violation, as determined by the judges.
11. Exceeding the course limits, including the braking or stop line will result in a 10 second penalty for each violation.

Edgemont Redneck Rally reserves the right to alter or update the rules. Rules updates will be posted as they occur. The final and binding rules will be read at the drivers meeting for this event. The rules read at the start of the event will override any and all previously posted rules or verbally communicated rules.
