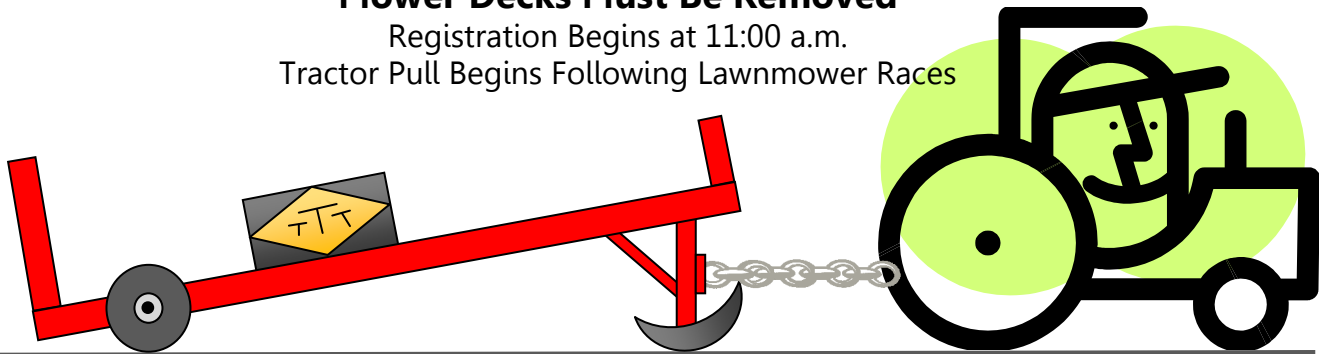

Mower Decks Must Be Removed

Tractor Pull Begins Following Lawnmower Races



- 4 Classes
- Class C-under 12 Hp; Class B-12-18 Hp; Class A-18-25 Hp; Xtreme Class-25+ Hp
- \$5.00 Entry Fee – Total Entry Fee Awarded In Prizes
- Prizes & Trophies Top 2 Each Class
- A-B-C Classes Must Be Lawn/Garden Tractor Variety with the Stock Engines with a Maximum of Two Cylinders
- Xtreme Class Engines Must Be Lawn Tractor, ATV, Motorcycle, or Snowmobile Type
- Top 2 Each Class to Pull-Off
- Tractor Drawbar Point of Hook (Clevis) Must Be No Higher Than the Centerline of the Rear Axle to the Ground and Be Stationary
- No “Cut” Tires, Duels, Chains, or Studs
- Anyone 12 Years or Under Must Wear a Helmet and Be Able to Prove Their Ability to Handle the Lawnmower to an Official Before Being Allowed to Compete in A-B-C Classes
- No Alcohol or Intoxication Allowed
- Obscene Language Will Not Be Tolerated
- Wheelie Bars and Helmets Recommended – Not Required

LAWN/GARDEN TRACTOR PULLING RULES

Mower Decks Must Be Removed



1. Classes: C – under 12 Hp; B – 12 - 18 Hp; A – 18 – 25 Hp; Xtreme – 25 + Hp
2. Anyone 12 years or under must wear helmet and be able to prove their ability to handle the lawnmower to an official before being allowed to compete in A-B-C classes.
3. A-B-C classes must be lawn/garden tractor variety with the stock engines with a maximum of two cylinders.
4. Xtreme class engines must be lawn tractor, ATV, motorcycle, or snowmobile type.
Top 2 each class to pull-off.
5. Gas, diesel or LPG fuels only. No alcohol. No nitrous oxide. No race fuels. No octane boosters.
6. No “cut” tires, duels, chains, or studs.
7. Each lawn/garden tractor must have operation brakes.
8. Front and rear wheel weights must be mounted to the wheels. Other weights shall not extend more than 16 inches from front of lawnmower frame and front and side frame weights must be mounted and secured. Suitcase weights are allowed.
9. Tractor draw bar point of hook (clevis) must be no higher than the centerline of the rear axle to the ground, and be stationary.
10. Any part falling off the tractor after being hooked and until the tractor is unhooked will result in disqualification.
11. The tractor must remain within the defined “in bounds” track area during the pull.
12. No “full throttle” starts or jerking sled. First offense – restart, Second offense – disqualification.
13. Immediately after pulling, all tractors may be required to go through technical inspection again.
14. Driver must exhibit the ability to control the tractor at all times. This is to include during technical inspections, before pull, backing up to sled and after pulling.
15. Drivers must stay on the seat of the tractor at all times. Hands must be on the steering wheel, hand brakes, hand clutch or throttle at all times during the pull. Tractor must be in neutral while hooking up to sled.
16. No alcohol or intoxication allowed. Obscene language will not be tolerated.
17. Any questionable modifications or alterations will be reviewed by the rules committee to establish eligibility.
18. All rules will be interpreted by the Garden Tractor Rules Committee. Any unforeseen problems or oversights will be ruled on by the rules committee with their rulings being final.
19. Track and safety officials have the authority to enforce all rules as stated herein and to disqualify any tractor for violations or unsafe conditions. All decisions are final.
20. Wheelie bars and helmets recommended.
